

Ferret Hind-End Problems

Possible hind-end problems that may cause your ferret to have a walking problem.

The following conditions, in no particular order, are known to cause hind-end weakness in ferrets:

- Hypoglycemia (insulinoma)
- Cancer (lymphoma)
- Aleutian disease virus
- Heart disease
- Toxin ingestion
- Anemia
- Discomfort (enlarged spleen, urinary obstruction)
- Injury/fractures
- Intervertebral disc disease
- Thromboembolism
- Chordomas
- Poor appetite
- Proliferative bowel disease
- Vomiting
- Myeloma
- Sepsis (blood-borne infection)
- Liver disease
- Kidney disease
